Liverpool's service will honour the previous week's event, providing an opportunity for those unable to attend previously. Adoremus Liverpool is part of the Archdiocese's preparation for the Jubilee in 2025. Everyone is welcome to attend.

What to expect

There will be **Eucharistic Adoration** throughout the day from **10am** until **5pm**, **Holy Mass**, opportunities for **confession**, a variety of **workshops**, and a shared time of **prayer** during the day for all. All visitors are welcome to drop in and out throughout the day and only need to sign up to participate in the workshops due to the limited number of spaces.
